Shan You is 25 this year! We were established in 1995 to provide mental health and community wellness services to the community. Aligned with our mission, we are pleased to launch **Shan You 25**, a mental wellness initiative for **full-time students, seniors and unemployed persons**. We hope to support their psychological and emotional resilience during this period as they face a multitude of challenges in their daily lives.

The Details

- For Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents who are:
 - Full-time students age 16-25 years
 - Unemployed individuals age 21 years and above
 - Seniors age 55 years and above
- Each approved applicant will be offered up to **5 counselling sessions at a special subsidised rate of \$25/session**.
- Sessions can be scheduled from 1 September 2020 to 31 March 2021 subject to availability.

Our centre provides evidence-based counselling and mindfulness-based services to the community regardless of race and religion. Through our services, we hope to build a mentally healthy and compassionate community where all are empowered to live good and meaningful lives.
